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The Salvation Army Outdoors has created partnerships to make matching equipment grants available to certain corps/community centers. Use the following check list to certify your eligibility. Obtain required signatures and submit the application for consideration.

- Have an adequate facility (Minimum size is 30ft x 50ft, and at least a 10ft ceiling). This may be a gymnasium, multi-purpose room, on site or off site.
- Speak to local schools to see if they have a National Archery in School Program (NASP). They may be willing to help you!
- Have two committed staff/volunteers willing to be trained as NASP basic archery instructors. (DHQ/THQ can help with certifications.)
- Form advisory committee.
- Show a proposed weekly schedule of range time for program participants.
- Be willing to keep a record of attendance and individual score improvement statistics.
- Commit to competing in annual tournaments on site and online.
- Use archery as an outreach with *Centershot Ministries* curriculum.
- Commit to raising funds for equipment (\$750.00 for equipment, \$1,000.00 annual budget line for upkeep).
- Obtain Corps Council and Advisory Board approval.
- Obtain Divisional Finance Board Approval.
