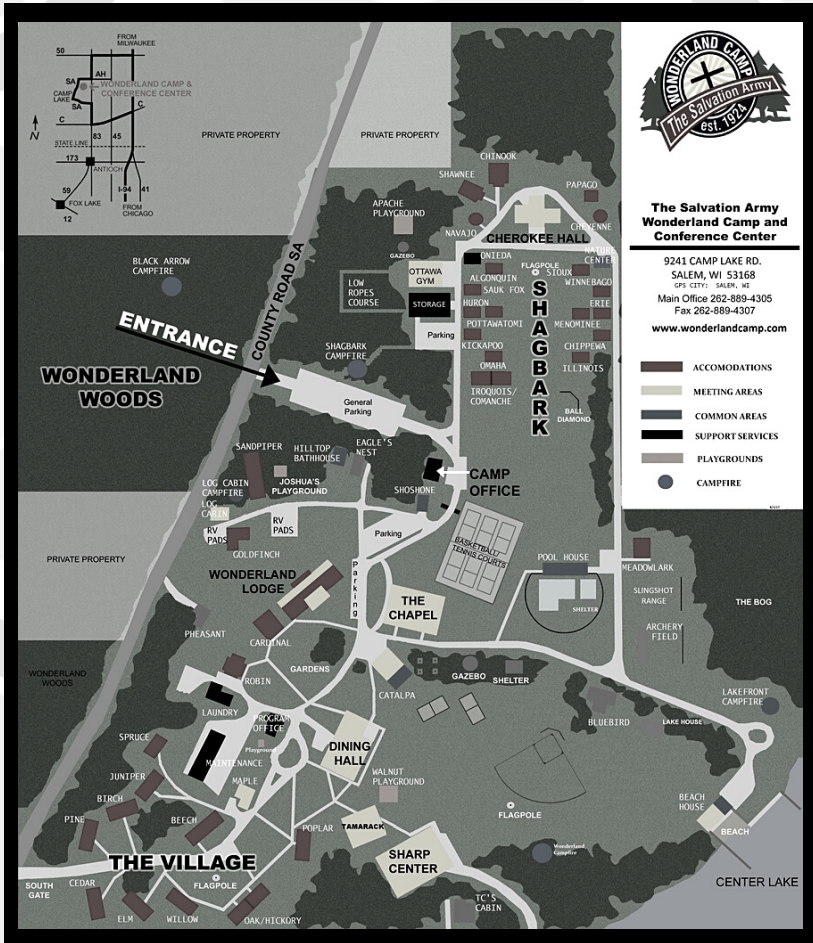

Keynote Sessions

Keynote Sessions are the foundation of Regeneration. This year we are focusing on Jeremiah 29: 4-14. The hope is to encourage you as you wholeheartedly seek God and trust his plans for a future and a hope, even when circumstances are temporary and imperfect. We are very excited to have Candice Wynn coming to speak and Timothy Reddick is leading worship. Each session will also include a corporate time of prayer and contemplation. Prayer Room

There is a designated space for prayer throughout the weekend. Personal Ministry Plan

As part of the experience, you will be challenged to create a Personal Ministry Plan. This plan will help you put your faith into action and provide an initial, concrete plan for when you return home to your corps, community, school, etc. As a follow up we will mail copies of your plan to you and your corps officer/youth pastor after the event. Doing so will help stimulate accountability in your mission and include others in the development process.

Missions Project

For Regeneration 2023, we are raising money for Salvation Army Child Development Centers in Sri Lanka. Children reside in Child Development Centers because their parents are unable to care for them or a court has ordered it for their protection. A small grant for each child will allow the staff to take them on a shopping trip for clothing and personal items. This also serves as an opportunity for them to make their own choices and learn about shopping and budgeting. Inflation is rapidly rising, but approximately \$25-\$30 will cover the cost of one child. Will you help us raise \$1,500?
